Subject: Notice about Roseola

Dear Parent or Guardian:

Someone in our child care has **roseola**. This is a common illness in young children. A virus causes it.

The symptoms are sudden fever and rash. The fever can go up to 106°F. It can last for 3 to 5 days. A few days after the fever starts, a pink rash (bumps) will appear. The rash can last for one to two days.

You should contact your health care provider if your child gets these symptoms.

If your child gets roseola, he or she cannot return to the child care center until the fever and rash are gone.

Please let us know if your child gets roseola.
